



In a world where the cries of women, girls, and children echo in the shadows of injustice, UNANIMA International emerges as a beacon of hope, a force against the tide of suffering.



What Impact does UNANIMA have on us as Holy Union Women?






What can we do (INDIVIDUALLY / COMMUNITY) as Holy Union Women to practically be part of this UNANIMA MISSION (UI)?

- ► We are all invited to ADVOCATE, create AWARENESS, and offer SCHOLARSHIPS in and through our various schools and health centers to at least one Child each year.
- ► Encourage our women not to give up on learning a trade that can generate income. This will go a long way toward reducing poverty and preserving the dignity of women, girls, and children.
- Report any case of Abuse and treat it seriously.
- ▶ Offer formal and informal education to women, girls, and children.
